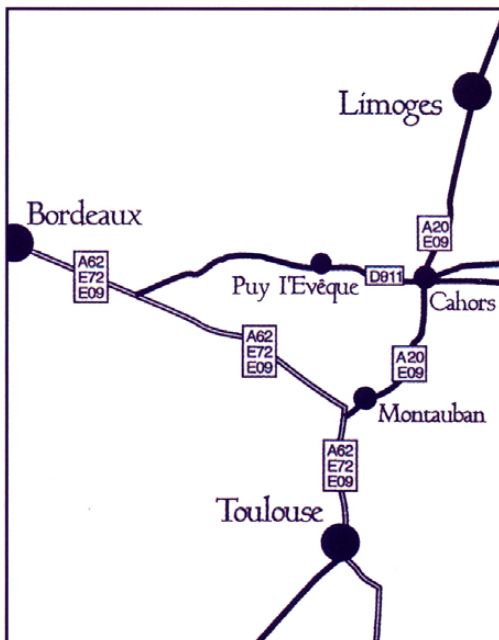

Travel Details

For those flying, Puy l'Evêque is an hour's drive from Bergerac, and one and a half hours from Toulouse. The owner can arrange to pick you up from the airport for a small fee.

For those driving from the UK, Puy l'Evêque is 30 minutes from the main A20 auto-route at nearby Cahors.



Location

Set amongst the South-west France famous **Cahors** vineyards of the Midi Pyrenees, is the historic village of **Puy l'Evêque**, or 'Hill of the Bishop'.

The Lot department is famous for its medieval villages and also convenient to visit are other well known historic sites such as 13th century **Chateau de Bonaguil** and **Rocamadour**, set into the side of a gorge.

Daytime temperatures can range between 18°C to 30°C in summer, ideal for exploring the local countryside.
